BENDIGO TRAMWAYS

Would you like to meet new people, show off your city and be part of Bendigo's nostalgic tram story? Join our passionate Tramways team, driving, riding, guiding or repairing vintage trams.

TRAM DRIVER

Play a key role in delivering our Vintage Talking Tram tour, private tram charters and special events like The Blues Tram.

Requirements: Complete conductor training and a Rail Safety Workers Medical, as well as written and practical driving tests.

TRAM CONDUCTOR

Greet, direct and help visitors from all over the world whilst assisting the Tram Driver with the operation of the tram.

Requirements: Cash handling, sales and customer service experience. Written and practical tests. Rail Safety Medical.

DEPOT & WORKSHOP TOUR GUIDES

Guide visitors through Australia's oldest operating tram depot.

Requirements: A keen interest in history and an ability to bring our tram's fascinating stories to life for visitors.

TRAM RESTORATION

Help keep Bendigo's history alive through the restoration of our heritage tram fleet and other refurbishment projects.

Requirements: Previous experience in a related trade such as engineering, wood working, upholstery, painting or mechanics.



CENTRAL DEBORAH GOLD MINE

Bendigo is a city built on gold. Help us keep our golden heritage alive by sharing stories about the gold that built this beautiful city and the miners who worked hard for every ounce.

SURFACE TOUR GUIDE

Encourage visitors to explore the surface of the mine. Answer questions, demonstrate equipment, and assist underground mine tour guides with 'kitting up' groups. **Requirements:**

Engaging, approachable and enthusiastic with a desire to learn and share the history of mining in Bendigo.



UNDERGROUND MAINTENANCE

Assist with underground mining maintenance including routine safety checks and upgrades.

Requirements: Must be comfortable working underground in a wet environment. Previous experience carrying out similar maintenance work would be beneficial.

MINE SURFACE MUSEUM MAINTENANCE

Get your hands dirty assisting with general maintenance of the mine's surface museum displays, machinery and buildings.

Requirements: An all-around handy-man or woman would be an asset to this welcoming team environment.



BENDIGO JOSS HOUSE TEMPLE

Built in the 1870s, the Bendigo Joss House Temple is one of the few remaining original buildings of its type in Australia. Dedicated volunteers keep this heritage-listed temple open for visitors and worshippers.

JOSS HOUSE TEMPLE TOUR GUIDE AND RECEPTIONIST

Greet and guide visitors around the historic Joss House. Care for the sacred temple the way the Chinese caretakers would have over 100 years ago, helping to keep it presentable and comfortable for visitors. Assist visitors with purchasing keepsakes from the souvenir shop and sell tickets to other Bendigo Heritage Attractions sites including mine and tram tours.

Requirements: An interest in history, specifically in Bendigo's connection to its Chinese heritage. A passion to share knowledge, meet groups from around the world and help to preserve one of Bendigo's oldest assets is essential. Volunteers will be trained in ticket and souvenir sales, as well as tour guiding.
